**FINAL SHOW CAUSE NOTICE U/S17**

**WHEREAS**, Recognition was granted to the institution namely **CSI. Bishop Newbiggin College of Education, No.109/60, Dr.Radhakrishnan Road, Mylopore, Chennai-600004, TamilNadu run by Church of South India Diocese of Madras, No.226, Cathedral Road, Post Box No.4914, Chennai-600086, TamilNadu** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2008-09/4384 dated 30.08.2008 for conducting (B.Ed.) Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2008-09.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted an affidavit dated 29.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 21.04.2015 for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of **100 students (two basic units)** from the academic session 2015-2016

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in 388<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> September 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the following requisite documents/VT Report accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause was issued to the institution on 05.01.2022. The institution vide letter dated 24.08.2022 has submitted a reply to the Show Cause Notice

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 414<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> September 2022 and the Committee decided as follows: -

*"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -*

*The institution was issued a Show Cause Notice (SCN). The institution has submitted its reply on 24.08.2022. The Committee perused the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.*

1. *The institution has not submitted a certified/notarised Land document.*
2. *The institution has submitted a NEC in regional language. The institution is required to submit English translated copy of the same.*
3. *The institution has not submitted CLU issued by the competent authority.*
4. *The institution has submitted a Notarized copy of Building plan in which Survey No., built-up area and multi-purpose hall area are not mentioned in the document and the same is not approved by the competent authority.*

5. *The website of the institution is not having complete information. Many of the essential documents as prescribed by Regulations are not seen on the website. The institution is required to reasons thereof. The Website of the institution should have complete information as required under clause 7(14) (i) regarding uploading the information about staff, infrastructure and instructional facilities, clause 8 (6) regarding display of Affidavit and clause 10 regarding display of account statements etc. of NCTE Regulations, 2014.*
6. *The faculty namely, S.Catherine was appointed after notification (dt. 09.06.2017) of NCTE (Amendment) Regulations, 2014 is not possessing NET/P.HD. qualification. The institution is required to submit consolidated Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format approved after issuance of this notice / last reminder. (In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by the Affiliating body for each of the recognised teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)*
7. *The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details*
  - (i) Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the Institution*
  - (ii) Details of land & building now available with the Institution*
  - (iii) Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status*

***In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof.***

***Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 7 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice."***

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the institution is required to submit the representation /compliance accompanied with an affidavit from the authorized representation of the Management. The representation along with an affidavit must reach this office within the time specified at the end.
